

## **Newport News City Hall STAFF Parking & Operational Impacts Friday, May 15 – Tuesday, May 26, 2026**

Please be advised of temporary parking and operational impacts in the City Hall area during the dates listed above.

### **Parking Lot Closures**

- The 23rd Street parking lots located at 98 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and 2295 Harbor Road will be closed to city staff and public use from 6 a.m. on Friday, May 15 until 5 p.m. on Tuesday, May 26.
- All vehicles **must** be removed from these lots by end of day Thursday, May 14.

### **Limited Parking at City Hall**

- Limited number of parking spaces will be available at City Hall for staff during this timeframe.
- Staff are encouraged to allow additional time for parking and travel to City Hall facilities.

### **Alternative Parking Locations for City Hall Employees**

City Hall staff should utilize the following alternate parking locations:

- **Huntington Parking Garage** – 300 25th St.
  - Staff must have city ID badge access prior to using the Huntington Parking Garage.
  - To request access, please email the ID Badge Office at idbadgeoffice@nnva.gov.
- **Huntington Surface Lot** – 2500 Huntington Ave.
  - City staff are not required to pay parking fees at the Huntington Surface Lot, but must have their valid city hall orange parking decal displayed

### **Accessibility Accommodations**

- Staff who may have difficulty walking from alternate parking locations should speak with their supervisor regarding accommodations. Department Directors should contact Andy Wilks at 757-884-6257 to reserve City Hall parking accommodations for staff who may need assistance.

### **City & Motor Pool Vehicles**

- All city and motor pool vehicles must be relocated to the top floor of the Justice Building Parking Garage located at 2501 Washington Ave. no later than 12 p.m. on Friday, May 22, 2026. Vehicles may return to the city hall lot on Tuesday, May 26, 2026.
- City and motor pool vehicles unable to fit in the Justice Building Parking Garage must park in the dead-end section of the City Hall parking lot located behind the gas pumps.

### **City Hall Operations – Friday, May 22**

- City Hall will cease in-person operations at 12 p.m. on Friday, May 22, 2026.
- All city hall offices should operate remotely.
